Scene 1

You are in Berlin, looking for a certain *Schreibwarenladen* (stationary store). You need some school supplies. You are lost in Berlin, currently standing in front of the *Deutsche Oper* (the German Opera House), in Charlottenburg, and you ask someone where *das Theater des Westens* is. The person explains on what street it is – *liegt in der* _____ *straße*.

Anforderungen¹ -

1. Use the device, *Entschuldigung* or *Verzeihung*, both meaning “excuse me”
2. Conversation about simple directions
3. Stroll to the stationary store
4. Mumble yourself in the store about what you need or buy (4 different items.)

(Start at der Deutschen Oper, your destination can be elsewhere)

****Extra Credit: a second exchange dealing with Berlin landmarks****

Scene 2

You run into a friend and another person you've never met. You greet each other, and your friend introduces his companion. He speaks with an accent and you ask where he's from. He explains (saying is a native of that country AND he's from that country), you ask if he lives in the capital city. He asks if you speak his mother tongue. You say you do, give a couple of examples, then inquire about other languages everyone speaks. Tell what nationalities your parents are.

¹ Anforderungen (pl) – requirements

Anforderungen -

1. Appropriate greetings from all
2. Differing accents
3. Conversation with new person (6 lines minimum)
4. Mention at least three different languages, nationalities, countries
5. Include mention of capital city
6. Phrases in one different second language. KEIN ENGLISH, bitte.

Every person writes their own skit.

Type it clearly, with roles clearly defined.

Two scenes (die Szene, -n): with titles in German.

Make 4 copies, one for me, one for you, and two for whomever you choose to perform your Theaterstück.
