Chapters 10 and 11 are the main bulk of the exam, with several blasts from the past.

First, Listening exercises, from Chapter 10, then Chapter 11. Pictures to analyze, and statements on the pictures, you tell me if the statements are true or false, based on the illustrations.

- Know your sports vocabulary – page 292, Genders of these sports also!

- der Fußballplatz – *soccer field*
- know that there are some verbs that take dative case objects – page 312
- know the expression: Die Hand tut mir weh. - *my hand hurts*.

Kapitel 11 – written section – Reisen

1. pages 343 and 357: This vocabulary you will encounter!!
2. erzählen – *to tell*
3. die Reise – *the trip*
4. umsteigen – *to change trains, transfer in a city to another train, bus, etc.*
5. das Gleis – *the track, train track, track platform*
6. know the various forms of transportation, genders too!!
7. Be able to give simple directions. There will be a map exercise.
8. Past participles of commonly used/seen verbs.
9. Know how to conjugate the two helping verbs: haben and sein.

Assorted stuff – the grammar summary on page 387 ff. ought to be reviewed closely.

Wie? Wo? Was? Wer? - know what these essential question words mean.

the conjugation of haben is crucially important!!!

the conjugation of sein is terribly important!!!!
