

## Kapitel 6 Projektideen

**Rotkäppchen Büchlein** – Write a children's book around the Rotkäppchen story. Use the Sentences on exercise 13 from the worksheet as a skeleton; for each sentence add at least two sentences to elaborate and confabulate. Prepare a decorative booklet, with at least 6 pages, text typewritten, preferably proofread by me. Review the Rotkäppchen version on page 45 in your text for further ideas. **Do not simply copy that version for your story.** Create your own version.

**Ein Mensch von der Hansezeit** – create a Steckbrief of an imaginary person from a city in the Hanseatic League. This person is somehow associated with the commerce of the Hansa. Give them a name, a city of origin, an occupation, a story. Use a snapshot of yourself, clip it, and draw around your face/head/shoulders an illustration of your person. Here are some occupation ideas:

You probably can think of other occupations that are easily associated with the trade and commerce of the Hanseatic League. Use <http://dict.leo.org/> for vocabulary, and the Internet to research life in the Hanse. I have a few links posted at our website on the Hanse. What should you write about this person? How long they've been doing this work, where they learned the trade/skill, a typical day at your line of work. Text should be typed and your Steckbrief must include both your illustration and text.

**Deutsche Museen** – on exercise 18 from the worksheets you see a large collection of museums. Write a short report on a museum, **in German**, telling where exactly the museum is, its hours of operation, fees and costs, different permanent exhibits there, when the museum was founded, and other interesting attributes. Include pictures from the website in your report. Tell why you chose this museum to report on. **DO not use online translators when writing this report. Write original German sentences.** Keep things simple. And no copying large chunks of text from these websites and claim it as your own.

**Grammatik – die Modalverben** – write a paper on the modal verbs in German, illustrating its conjugations in the present, imperfect, present perfect and also their use with double infinitive constructions. Your charts should include **original explanatory text, in English**, of the verbs themselves and how their various forms are conjugated. Discuss their meanings and give English equivalents. Include a detailed discussion on the formation of the subjunctive moods of the modal verbs, in both the present tense and past tense. Include English translations of all German examples of the modal verbs in your booklet. Discuss word order when using these modal verbs in the various tenses.

Choose one of these projects. Do another one for extra credit.
