The main source of phrases, vocabulary and attitude can found in the **Einstieg in das Thema, Seite 53ff** and the Kulturstück, **Interview: „Bei den Wessis ist jeder für sich“, Seiten 55ff**. Also the table you completed for this reading can be useful to you as you prepare your conversation.

Requirements for the conversation:

1. One person is from Jena and speak positively about life in the DDR and negatively about prejudices felt in western Germany.
2. The other person is from Köln and expresses amazement as to how anyone would speak positively about DDR. Person acknowledges that problems exist in Eastern Germany, but believes that **nach der Wende** life became better for Germans in the former DDR states.
3. Conversation must have a coherent introduction, with a topic statement that opens discussion on life in newly unified Germany and prejudices that east Germans feel.

You may prepare a large index card with only the following on it:

7 pieces of vocabulary you plan to use – vocabulary being defined as:

1. single nouns with gender
2. verbal expressions – incomplete, non-conjugated infinitive phrases
3. adverbial words/phrases

3 rebuttal style phrases that facilitate expressing opinions

This is all that can appear on your index card. I'll examine them before you commence with your conversation.
