1. Review and re-read the sections in the book we are currently covering.
2. Write your homework assignments neatly, completely and carefully. Title your homework
3. Read the exercises aloud
4. Read the reading selections aloud
5. Study graded homework assignments to see what you did wrong.
6. Always read aloud as you review current homework assignments
7. Have simple conversations with yourself using the current vocabulary.
8. Use different voices as you engage yourself in conversation.
9. In your German notebook, write down key vocabulary and phrases from the current chapter.
10. Create and memorize sentences with current vocabulary.
11. Identify objects in your home, at school, anywhere you are.
